SUMMER PROGRAM French Language (All Levels), Art & Culture Plus Five Days In Paris!





PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Purchase College, SUNY five-week summer program in Antibes, Frances combines intensive work in the French language (all levels) with study of an English-taught elective in the Humanities, Fine Arts, or Social Sciences. The program ends with a five-day stay in Paris.

LOCATION

Located between Nice and Cannes, with 25 km of sandy beaches and 300 sunny days a year, Antibes is one of the Côte d'Azur's star attractions! Situated in southern France and surrounded by fortified walls, Antibes embodies the Côte d'Azur's historic and Mediterranean heritage. Antibes is second largest city on the French Riviera, and was the only town between Marseille and Italy for many years. The chateau, bastion and towers have today been transformed into a variety of cultural, artistic, and historic museums.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Students live with host families in either double rooms or singles. Breakfast and dinner are taken with the host family. Lunch may be taken at the school or in any of the many cafés and restaurants in town. Families are all carefully screened; students are placed according to their interests and needs (vegetarian, non-smoking, loves children, loves animals, etc.).

CLASSES & ACTIVITIES

Students enroll in a French language class (beginning through advanced) and an elective for a total of eight credits. Students will be placed in a language class appropriate to their level, after a brief placement exam.

Language classes are taught each morning in a modern, well-established school (CIA: **Centre International d'Antibes**).

Before returning to New York, students will be able to explore the many wonders of Paris, "The City of Lights," in addition to visiting historic sites such as the Eiffel Tower, the Arc de Triumph or Notre Dame Cathedral. The palace of Versailles is just a short train ride away.

COST

Students should plan to bring additional spending money for some meals, as well as for miscellaneous personal expenses. International health insurance is required and available through SUNY.

For Purchase or other SUNY students, existing financial aid awards can usually be applied to summer programs; home campus Financial Aid Offices will have further details. Alternative loans are available to cover summer study.

Please submit your application online with a copy of your transcript, a short statement why you want to participate in the program, and a letter of recommendation from a faculty member (may be mailed separately).
