

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Purchase College, SUNY conducts a four-week summer program in Madrid, Spain. Students will pursue the intensive study of Spanish language and culture, along with English-taught elective courses from a variety of fields of study (Art History, Visual Arts, Social Sciences, Management). Classes are conducted at the Universidad Antonio de Nebrija and are taught by Spanish faculty.

LOCATION

The program is located in Madrid, which is the center of government, the home of the Spanish Parliament (las Cortes) and is a thriving cultural and educational Capitol City.

A metropolis of three million, Madrid is also known as the artistic centre of Spain with world-renowned museums and galleries and an active nightlife. The Nebrija campus is located in the vibrant university area of the city.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Students live with host families in either double rooms or singles. Breakfast and dinner are taken with the host family. Students may also live in residences on the University campus with other international students for an additional fee.

CLASSES & ACTIVITIES

Students participate with other students from around the world in the Hispanic Studies Programs, which includes complementary activities such as movies, guided walks through old Madrid, visits to the Prado Museum, Archaeological Museum, Royal Palace, Senate, Congress, etc. Students participating in the summer program can opt to spend a long weekend enjoying the sights and cultural attractions of Barcelona for an additional fee.

Students enroll for a Spanish language class (beginning through advanced) plus one elective for a total of seven credits.

Students who have studied Spanish will be placed in a class appropriate to their level, after a brief placement test. Please refer to the website for a complete description of language and elective courses: purchase.abroadoffice.net/shortterm.html.

COST

Please refer to the Spain program website (purchase.abroadoffice.net/shortterm.html) for program costs. All costs are subject to change. A non-refundable deposit is due within two weeks of acceptance.

Students should plan to bring additional spending money for some meals, as well as for miscellaneous personal expenses. International health insurance is required and available through SUNY.

For Purchase or other SUNY students, existing financial aid awards can usually be applied to summer programs; home campus Financial Aid Offices will have further details. Alternative loans are available to cover summer study.

APPLICATION

Please submit your application online with a copy of your transcript, a short statement why you want to participate in the program, and a letter of recommendation from a faculty member (may be mailed separately).

DEADLINE: Early-to-Mid March
